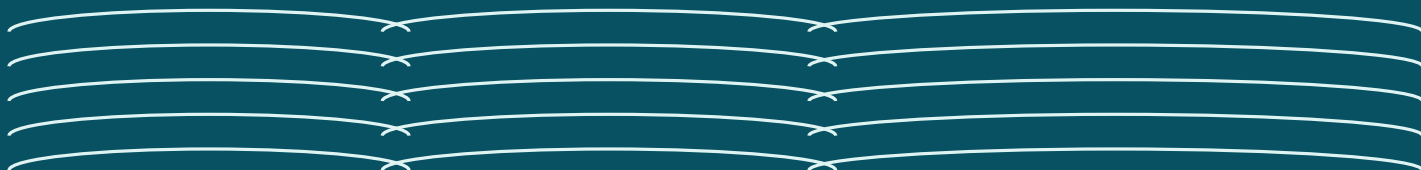
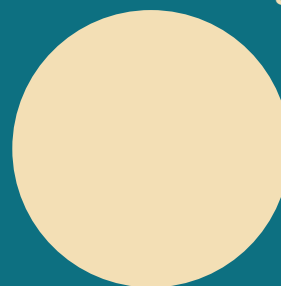

Mixed-Age Group Outing Planner

Reliable group anchors

Start with	Why it works	Watch for
Venice	Walkable and understandable with food and water nearby	Do not overbuild the town-and-pier pattern.
Punta Gorda Harborfront	Water views, seating, and a manageable shared anchor	Keep walking optional for lower-energy people.
St. Armands + Lido	Browsing, food, and beach access can stay close	Heat and peak parking can add friction.
Sarasota attraction day	A clearer structured plan when improvising would create friction	Choose one attraction and a nearby meal.

Keep it simple

- Short walks, food, seating, bathrooms, and flexible timing are quality features.
- Parks can work better than forcing a full attraction day.
- The strongest group plan usually has one shared anchor and optional participation around it.

Group-comfort checklist

- ☐ Someone can sit while others walk.
- ☐ Bathrooms and food are easy to reach.
- ☐ The plan still works if one person opts out of the extra stop.
- ☐ Walking distance is honest for the least-mobile person.
- ☐ The day has a shade, heat, or rain adjustment.
- ☐ The group has one clear meetup point.
- ☐ We know the leave-early cue.
- ☐ We will confirm current access on the live guide.
