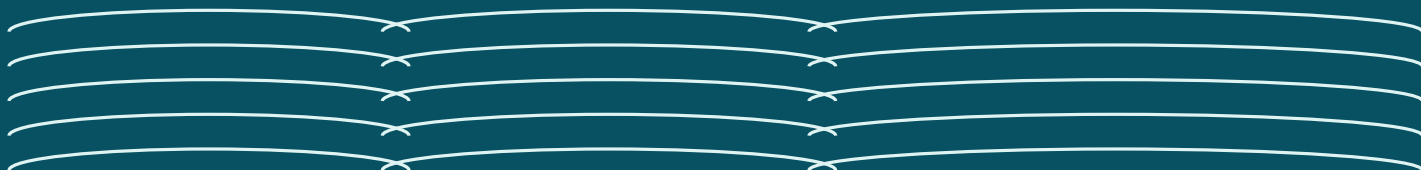
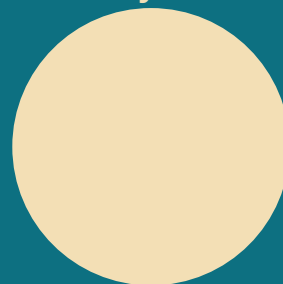

One Good Day From Englewood

A simple Englewood rhythm

Part	Default move	Keep it easy
Primary anchor	Dearborn Street, Old Englewood, or nearby water	Choose town or water first; do not make both compete.
Meal or walk	One coffee, lunch, or short town walk	Use the middle of the day as support, not a second itinerary.
Optional finish	Beach or another water stop	Add it only while the day still feels loose.

Keep it simple

- Englewood works because the pace is slower and the town texture is enough.
- Choose Venice when you want the easiest all-around answer.
- Choose Boca Grande when the drive should end with a stronger scenic payoff.

Before you leave Englewood

- ☐ Choose Dearborn Street or water as the main anchor.
- ☐ Keep one meal or coffee stop close to the anchor.
- ☐ Use only one water add-on.
- ☐ Leave before the calm day becomes an overbuilt day.
- ☐ Keep the schedule loose enough to adjust for heat or weather.
- ☐ Check current access and exact stop options on the live guide.
