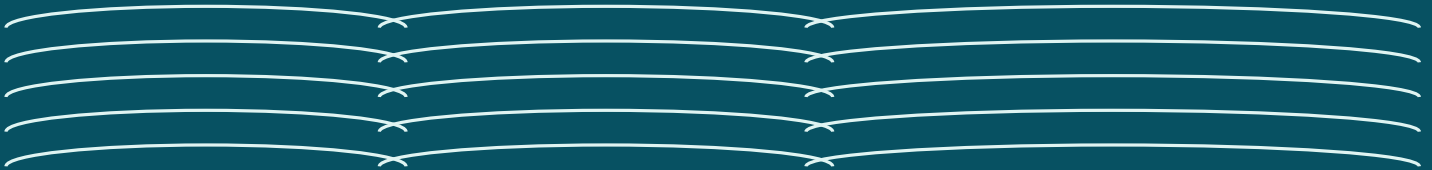
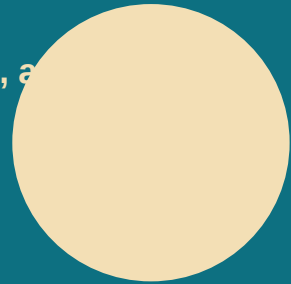


Shelling and Beachcombing Field Sheet

A slower shoreline planner for shells, shark teeth, and beachcombing



USE THIS WHEN

The shoreline itself is the attraction and the day needs more purpose than simply sitting on the beach.

LIVE GUIDE

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Use the site for current access, hours, parking, closures, and exact stop selection.



Shelling and Beachcombing Field Sheet

Pick the beachcombing style

Area	Best fit	Day shape
Venice	Shark-tooth identity plus an easy town plan	Walk, search, then use town or food as support.
Boca Grande	Quieter, slower, destination-like beachcombing	Let the shoreline and scenic mood carry the day.
Fort Myers southern end	Shelling as part of a larger refuge or attraction day	Keep the hunt as one part of the broader outing.
Nokomis / Englewood	Simple shoreline walking tied to food or a short stop	Low-cost, low-pressure, easy to keep short.

Keep it simple

- Do not promise perfect finds; choose a shoreline rhythm that makes searching enjoyable.
- A slower pace and flexible food/parking plan fit this activity best.
- Keep the beach day low-pressure and let the hunt provide the purpose.
